

Apply

- **Use knowledge and understanding in response to a given situation or real circumstances.**
- **Use an idea, equation, principle, theory or law to a given problem or issue**

Communicate

- **Express oneself in such a way that one is readily and clearly understood.**
- **Convey information about the exchange of thoughts, messages, or information through, for example, speech, signals, writing or behaviour.**

Demonstrate

- **Prove or make clear by reasoning or evidence, illustrating with examples or practical application**

Describe

- **Give a detailed account or picture of a situation, event, pattern, or process**

Discuss

- **Offer a considered and balanced review that includes a range of arguments, factors or hypotheses.**
- **Opinions or conclusions should be presented clearly and supported by appropriate evidence.**

Explain

- **Give a detailed account including reasons or causes.**

Identify

- **Provide an answer from a number of possibilities.**
- **Recognise and state briefly a distinguishing fact or feature.**

Justify

- **Give valid reasons or evidence to support an answer or conclusion.**

Prove

- **Use a sequence of logical steps to obtain the required result in a formal way.**

Select

- **Choose from a list or group**

Solve

- **Obtain the answer(s) using algebraic and/or numerical and/or graphical methods.**

State

- **Give a specific name, value or other brief answer without explanation or calculation.**

Suggest

- **Propose a solution, hypothesis or other possible answer.**

Use

- **Apply knowledge or rules to put theory into practice**

Verify

- **Provide evidence that validates the result**
